An individual awarded the Certified Medical Audit Specialist (CMAS) credential agrees to conduct himself/herself in an ethical and professional manner. By accepting the certification requirements the candidate agrees to uphold the values and ethics of the AAMAS and to follow the AAMAS standards and bylaws, including the guidelines outlined in the National Health Care Billing Audit Guidelines.

ETHICS STATEMENT

AAMAS promotes a culture of professionalism that upholds the principles of integrity, the promotion of competency, legislative and regulatory compliance, and the personal and professional standards of conduct of the medical audit specialist.

REQUIREMENTS FOR EXAMINATION

- ◆ Must be an active member of AAMAS (The AAMAS membership requirement is based on dues paid by January 31st of the year of the examination.)
- ◆ Two years authenticated health care audit experience (at least 20 hrs/week minimum)
- ◆ Two years health care experience
- ◆ Minimum 60 college semester units or licensed healthcare professional
- ◆ One college level or Council approved course in Accounting, Finance, Mathematics, or Statistics

The CMAS certification examination is given at the AAMAS national conference. Arrangements can be made for the examination to be administered at additional sites during the months of September through November. Details for on site testing are available from members of the Certification Council.



ROLE VALIDATED CMAS EXAMINATION

The CMAS examination is based on four main core curriculum domains. Each domain is supported by task-specific categories and sub-categories that represent the scope and job responsibilities of medical auditors nationally. The scope and job responsibilities were determined through a national Job Task Analysis survey or Role Delineation studies.

The four main core curriculum domains include:

- I. Professional Standards and Behavior
- II. Medical Audit Process and Methodology
- III. Medical Audit Skill
- IV. Medical Audit Environment

Recertification is required every three years.

Requirements for recertification include continuous active membership in AAMAS and 36 hours of CMAS Continuing Education Units. Eighteen hours must be related to Medical Audit Process and Methodology. The remaining CMAS CEU's must address other domains related to medical audit.
