Submissions can include dissertation abstracts, research in progress, DNP projects and evidence based practice activities including clinical projects, health care policy changes, clinical outcomes/evaluations projects, translational research, clinical dissertations, and practice innovations designed to improve the quality of care and implementation of nursing practice.

Individuals should use the online form. Instructions to register and enter research data are available on the library site.
